Jean-Michel Cousteau Fiji Islands Resort balances its dedication to the Fijian environment and culture with luxury and pampering. Conservation and preservation of the natural surroundings are integrated into every aspect of the resort's philosophy and operations. From the use of solar energy, Fiji's first water reclamation plant, eco-sensitive design and landscaping, to composting, organic gardens and community programs, the resort immerses its visitors into an environmentally responsible experience. The resort offers an unprecedented array of eco-activities, many led by the resident Marine Biologist or award-winning Cultural Host. As its name suggests, the resort features one of the top dive operations in Fiji, one dedicated to preserving the delicate reefs.

Jean-Michel Cousteau Fiji Islands Resort is located on the island of Vanua Levu on a former 17-acre coconut plantation overlooking the pristine waters of Savusavu Bay. Accommodations are 24 Fijian-style, thatched-roof oceanfront or garden view bures scattered among elegant palm trees, as well as the 2,000-square-foot Villa, considered the most luxurious accommodation in Fiji.

Post Ranch Inn, since its inception 15 years ago, has continued to garner praise from industry critics and travelers alike. It was the first resort to be built in the Big Sur area in two decades and the only resort to meet the stringent environmental standards of the Big Sur Land Use Plan. Today it is known for its organic style and for using natural materials of glass, wood and stone when possible. Guest rooms blend into the landscape, and the intent behind the stilted tree houses was to protect the fragile root balls of the nearby redwood trees. The hotel also created the first commercial gray water system approved in California.

Guests benefit from local culture. Reflecting the history of the past, the guest rooms are all named after Big Sur pioneers. Ten new rooms will be added summer of 2007 and they will be named after women of the Big Sur area. Bill Post, whose family owned the land on which Post Ranch Inn is built, is active at the resort and hosts several times a week a breakfast to engage guests on the history of the area. In addition, the community benefits, Land was made available for a firehouse for the Big Sur Volunteer Fire Brigade and a local ambulance company. Rare, threatened and endangered species have been identified and are protected at Post Ranch Inn, including the Smith's Blue Butterfly and California Red Legged Frog. The landscape is filled with native and drought-tolerant plants tended with organic fertilizers.
